



Job Description

Position: Warehouse and Yard Lead (Ft Worth)

Reporting: Reports directly to the Branch Manager

Purpose: This position oversees and directs the yard/whse team, working with both internal and external customers in the commercial sales yard, assisting with the loading and unloading of orders for customers and delivery drivers. Yard associates are also responsible for receiving and unloading incoming vendor deliveries, confirming the accuracy of the deliveries, and inspecting the delivered goods for damages. Yard associates are responsible for restocking the deliveries, once verified.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Load orders on BarnSCO fleet trailers and customer owned vehicles in a safe and responsible manner.
- Unload and receive vendor trucks and trailers in a safe and responsible manner.
- Restock all goods and materials received daily from vendors.
- Verify and sign off on all loads leaving the yard to ensure safe and accurate loading.
- Work with the Safety Coordinator to ensure that all safety procedures are followed, and any safety violations are reported immediately to the safety coordinator.
- Process orders by scanning the appropriate ASA tags per directed requirements of the Branch Manager.
- Required to familiarize themselves with products that BarnSCO offers
- Assist the counter sales representatives by retrieving products for customers
- May be asked to assist with small maintenance duties within the facility
- Perform small preventative maintenance duties on forklifts used in the performance of duties.
- Keep warehouse and yard clean and free of trash and debris and organize as needed.
- Ensure that all time spent on the clock is providing value to the BarnSCO operation
- Other duties as requested by the Branch Manager.

Required Skills and Experience:

- Strong Communication (bi-lingual a plus), decision-making, problem solving, and team building skills.
- Basic computer skills a plus.
- Must have the ability to work overtime as needed, including Saturdays.
- Must have the ability and capability to start and operate equipment.
- Must have exceptional customer service skills and experience.
- Must be able to lift 75 pounds, full use of arms to hands to use tools, must be able to climb up and off equipment and be able to see close as well as distant.
