



## Job Description

**Position:** Junior Rebar Estimator

**Reporting:** Reports directly to the Estimating Manager

**Purpose:** The Junior Rebar Estimator is responsible for learning to accurately interpret civil, structural, and architectural plans in order to quantify rebar and related construction materials. This role supports the Estimating Manager by developing the skills necessary to prepare precise, timely, and comprehensive material quotes, ensuring customers receive accurate pricing and exceptional service. The position plays a key role in supporting sales efforts, maintaining strong customer communication, and contributing to the overall efficiency and profitability of the estimating department.

### **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Prepare accurate, complete, and timely rebar and material quotes based on customer-provided plans and specifications.
- Analyze and interpret bid item lists to determine BarnSCO's scope of work.
- Read and interpret civil, structural, architectural, TXDot, and municipal plans and specifications.
- Download and manage project plans from various web-based plan rooms and platforms (e.g., TXDot, iSqFt, Dropbox, etc.).
- Perform detailed material quantity takeoffs from plans and bid documents.
- Develop thorough written quotes including item descriptions, pricing, and applicable terms.
- Revise and update quotes as addendums or revised plans are issued.
- Research and source pricing for non-stock or special-order items and incorporate findings into project estimates.
- Utilize Microsoft Excel and other operating systems to generate, track, and manage estimates.
- Work autonomously to deliver high-volume, accurate quotes within tight deadlines.
- Communicate professionally with customers and internal sales staff regarding project details, clarifications, and pricing.
- Respond to customer and sales inquiries via phone and email in a timely manner.
- Collaborate across departments to ensure accurate pricing, product availability, and order fulfillment.
- Apply three-dimensional thinking to accurately visualize and interpret structural components from two-dimensional drawings.

- Prior experience in construction or a related field preferred.
- Strong verbal and written communication skills.
- Demonstrated customer service mindset with the ability to interact professionally with customers and internal teams.
- Working knowledge of Microsoft Excel.
