



Job Description

Position: Fabrication Shop Associate – Fort Worth

Reporting: Fabrication Shop Supervisor or Branch Manager

Purpose: As an associate working in the fabrication shop in Fort Worth, employee will be tasked with assisting the fab shop supervisor in the production of rebar, redwood and fiber fabrication. Employee will report directly to, and receive daily instructions from, the fab shop supervisor. Employee will be responsible for the safe operation of certain fabrication machines and tools including, but not limited to, formula fabricating machine, table-top bending machine, rebar shearing machine, table-top scroll saw, band saw, drill press and various electric hand tools. Employee will receive full, supervised training on each tool and machine before being allowed to operate them without supervision.

Job responsibilities will include, but not be limited to:

- Fabrication of both stock and custom rebar orders, as instructed by shop supervisor.
- Fabrication of both stock and custom redwood orders, as instructed by shop supervisor.
- Fabrication of both stock and customer fiber expansion orders, as instructed by shop supervisor.
- General maintenance and cleaning of all tools and machines used to perform daily duties.
- Manage the maintenance of a clean, safe workplace and demand immediate reporting of all incidents to Safety Personnel and HR
- Demonstrate Leadership consistent with the BarnSCO Core Values

Job Requirements:

- Previous carpentry/fabrication experience preferred but not mandatory.
- Ability to program computer-controlled equipment/machines (training provided).
- Must be proficient in basic math (addition, subtraction, division & multiplication)
- Must be able to stand on feet for long periods of time as job requires.
- Must be able to lift at least 75lbs with no effects.
- Must be able to prepare detailed production reports on a daily basis (training provided).
- Must be able to meet strict production schedules consistently.
- Must be able to set and adhere to production goals.

Employee will be responsible for adhering to all Barnsco safety rules and regulations both in the fabrication shop and all other areas of Barnsco Fort Worth facility. Employee will also follow dress codes as required by Barnsco to work in the fabrication shop, including all safety and PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) required including, but not limited to:

- Hard Hat
- Safety glasses (at all times while in the fabrication shop)
- Proper work shoes/boots
